

## TOTALSPORTS WOMEN'S RACE — JOHANNESBURG 2026

RESIDENTS & LOCAL BUSINESS NOTIFICATION — ROAD CLOSURES, SUNDAY 16 AUGUST 2026

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Totalsports Women's Race Johannesburg (10km & 5km) takes place on Sunday, 16 August 2026, starting and finishing at Marks Park Sports Club, Judith Street, Parkview. The event route passes through the Parkview, Westcliff, Greenside and Emmarentia precincts. This event is fully compliant with all City of Johannesburg Joint Operations Committee (COJ JOC) requirements and is supported on the day by the Johannesburg Metropolitan Police Department (JMPD). Temporary road closures will be in effect as set out below to ensure participant and road-user safety.

### ACCESS DURING THE EVENT

Closures are progressive — each road reopens as soon as the last participant and the sweeper vehicle have passed, on the instruction of the event Venue Operations Centre (VOC). Resident and emergency vehicle access will be facilitated by JMPD officers and event marshals stationed at all closure points wherever safely possible. Please plan your movements around the above times, and allow additional travel time if departing or returning during the closure window.
